




- Pursuant to the City Charter (Section 3.01), the Mayor shall:


- On 8/3/18, the Governing Body convened to fulfill their Charter obligation and to review/update the 2017-2022 City Strategic Plan






Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- Modification to State law sought to allow municipalities to have greater access to Gross Receipts Tax reporting information
- Other legislative priorities for 2019 NM Legislature Session discussion at September Governing Body work session
- Staff will prepare a Legislative Priorities Resolution for Governing Body consideration prior to the start of the 2019 NM Legislature Session in January




Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- Changing Municipal Election & Runoff Election provisions
- Staff will further research the issue
- Staff will bring research results and options/proposals to Governing Body at the start of the new year




Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- Modifying Charter Review Process (i.e., level of appointed citizen commission involvement and control related to questions submitted for voter approval)
- Staff advises that the Governing Body discuss further at a future work session meeting in order to give consensus on what staff is to research further




Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- City officials meeting regularly with County and School District officials to discuss issues of mutual interest
- Staff will reach out to other entities and develop a meeting calendar; draft calendar will be presented to the Governing Body




Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- City Councilor town hall meetings; additional community engagement opportunities
- Combining with Coffee with Cop discussed with Police Department; initially the preference would be to keep this event as a space for community members to build a relationship with law enforcement
- Mayor Hull plans on holding a town hall meeting, in conjunction with City Councilors, in each City Council District this fall to provide a city update
- Staff advises that the Governing Body discuss further at a future work session meeting to explore different ideas




Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- Santa Ana Star Center management RFP (forthcoming with associated discussion); facility event (type and attendance) data will be sent via e-mail
- Review of funding options available (bonding capacity and remaining Gross Receipts Tax increments); will be handled via memo
- Creation of safe zone for social media sales/exchanges will have further review by staff




Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- Modifying Noise Ordinance
- Staff advises further research that can be discussed at a future Governing Body work session meeting



Hot Topics/Consensus/Follow-up

- Staff will prepare repeal of Vehicle Seizure and Forfeiture Ordinance for consideration
- Staff will prepare School/Social Media Threats Ordinance (modeled after Albuquerque) for consideration
- Staff will prepare repeal Ordinance for Low-Income Assistance Program (water/wastewater utility customers)
