Questions and Answers:

1. **Question:** Can the City provide a CAD file for the Unclassified Excavation to determine the Cut/Fill quantities.

Answer: The AutoCAD file (.DWG file format) can be downloaded on the City's IFB/RFP website at: www.rnm.gov/bids

2. **Question:** Will the project require Import/Export of Material or does the project site have the required material to balance the Unclassified Excavation item?

Answer: The project is not expected to require import. Bid Item 22 - Haul and Stockpile Salvageable Material (per NMDOT Specification Section 601), has been added to the Revised Bid Form, attached. Bid Item 22 shall include hauling of excess material from the project site to the City of Rio Rancho's Streets and Right-of-Way yard, near the intersection of Kim Road and Idalia Road, at 2016 Idalia Road NE.

3. **Question:** Will Material Testing be required on the project? Can the City provide an allowance to account for any Material Testing required?

Answer: Materials testing shall be completed per NMDOT Specification Section 906. For this project, Independent Assurance testing shall be required and is considered incidental to the contract.

4. **Question:** Is there a particular color for the vinyl chain link fence? Pricing varies based on the color selections. I believe black is the least expensive.

Answer: City requests the color black for the vinyl chain link fencing.

5. **Question:** Can the City provide a CAD file with a DXF or DWG file format. Please let me know if you need additional information.

Answer: The AutoCAD file (.DWG file format) can be downloaded on the City's IFB/RFP website at: rrnm.gov/bids

6. **Question:** Is it anticipated this project will be balanced material? If not, can the imported material be acquired on site or the export be placed on site? If so, where and will excess need to be stockpiled or spread?

Answer: The project is not expected to require import. Bid Item 22 - Haul and Stockpile Salvageable Material (per NMDOT Specification Section 601), has been added to the Revised Bid Form, attached. Bid Item 22 shall include hauling of excess material from the project site to the City Streets and Right-of-Way yard, near the intersection of Kim Road and Idalia Road, at 2016 Idalia Road NE.

7. **Question:** Is there a hydrant on site to access for construction water?

Answer: Contractor is responsible for obtaining the necessary permits and meters for obtaining construction water. A hydrant is available for use at the potable water tank near the security gate entrance.

8. **Question:** If testing is the responsibility of the contractor can an allowance be established?

Answer: Materials testing shall be completed per NMDOT Specification Section 906. For this project, Independent Assurance testing shall be required and is considered incidental to the contract.

9. **Question:** Will a temporary fence be required when the old fence is taken down before the new fence is installed?

Answer: A temporary fence will be required to prevent vehicles from traveling east on the access road to other areas of the City's yard. Temporary fencing can tie to corner posts at the east side of the tank, on the north and south sides of the existing access road.

10. Question: Will the site need to be secured?

Answer: A temporary fence will be required to prevent vehicles from traveling east on the access road to other areas of the City's yard. Temporary fencing can tie to corner posts at the east side of the tank, on the north and south sides of the existing access road.

BIDDER further agrees to pay, as liquidated damages, the amount of **Five Hundred dollars (\$ 500.00)** for each consecutive calendar day thereafter as provided in the Supplementary Conditions.
